Summer Student Job Post – Market Assistant – Programming

The Avon Community Farmers Market is looking to hire a dynamic student to be our Market Assistant, with a focus on programming and community engagement.

Reporting to the Market Manager, the role will largely focus on developing programming at the Market, which could include crafts, story time, photo booths, food demonstrations, or workshops. The successful applicant will also work with local community groups to take advantage of the free community table space the Market provides. As time allows, the role may also include outreach to potential vendors, with a focus on underrepresented groups. Having a current first aid certification is an asset.

This is a job for a people person. You will need to talk to vendors, customers, and community members, in person, digitally and on the phone.

The position will run for 9 weeks, 30 hours a week beginning June 30 and running until August 31. Hours of work will be Sundays at the Market, from 8 am to 3 pm. Other hours will be scheduled with the successful applicant. The position pays \$16.20/hour.
